Our supported housing work in Cornwall includes:

Penwith

- Penzance self-contained accommodation for 11 young people at risk.
- Penzance/Hayle - 2 self contained properties for people recovering from drug and alcohol misuse

Kerrier

- Redruth 1 self-contained property for people recovering from drug and alcohol misuse.
- Redruth/Camborne 17 self-contained properties for people with mental health issues
- Redruth accommodation for 16 homeless families.

Carrick

- Truro 2 self-contained properties for people recovering from drug and alcohol misuse.
- Truro accommodation for 15 single homeless.
- Truro accommodation for 5 people with mental health issues.
- Truro self-contained accommodation for 8 people with learning disabilities.
- Penryn accommodation for 6 homeless families
- 1 safe house for 6 women and their children escaping domestic violence.

Restormel

- Newquay self-contained accommodation for 10 people with mental health issues.
- 1 safe house for 8 women and their children escaping domestic violence.

N Cornwall

- Bodmin self-contained accommodation for four people with mental health issues.
- Launceston 3 self-contained properties for people recovering from drug and alcohol misuse.
- Launceston self-contained accommodation for 6 people with learning disabilities.

- Saltash accommodation for 6 people with mental health issues.
- Liskeard - accommodation for 8 young people at risk/leaving care.
